March was an amazing month for OEM in Central America.

- We were blessed with a group in Comayagua, Honduras from Along the Journey Ministries, who did evangelism, preaching, leadership and a three night crusade where many professions of faith were made and many lives changed.

- We received two groups in San Miguel, El Salvador.

FPC blessed us with 13 concerts in churches, schools and with a two night crusade.

They were followed by CLC, who did medical clinics for 4 days.

- We returned to Comayagua for a team from Fairview BC, who provided food for four communities as well as evangelism and preaching in the churches.

Police Ministry: We finished five leadership conferences and graduated 33 policeman. From their responses, they are now better equipped to serve the public. We are searching for the finances (\$2000) to construct a room to counsel abused women and to also provide the furniture for the room.

Government Ministry: We just provided our second leadership

conference to the Mayor and his department heads in Comayagua. An evaluation of their leadership skills displayed their urgent needs for leadership. We have committed to one session a month for 2011 to assist their team building efforts. We are praying that through this connection and blessing, OEM will be able to reach even top government officials.

University Ministry: With the help of our Zone Pastor, Mario Santos, we have begun a series of leadership classes with university students, professors, directors, and others.

In addition: Our churches, pastors, the Fire Department, Military and many other areas are being reached.

OEM's Interns, Hillary Harrell (medical) and Adrienne Levy (leadership) are providing many blessings to Honduras and El Salvador.

- Hillary, who is a nurse, has seen approximately 450 patients in several areas of Honduras and El Salvador since her arrival and has a very busy schedule until she leaves on May 3.
- Adrienne is to begin teaching English to Pastors, churches, and individuals on April 25th.

As we continue to expand and receive more mission teams in El Salvador, Honduras, Nicaragua, and Costa Rica, please pray for us in these areas

- For the Lord of the Harvest to send more laborers; for the fields are ripe with harvest.
- For additional finances and resources so we can bless those who will bless others.
- For four building projects we are waiting to start for very worthy causes.
- For strength, energy and good health as we continue to reach more people with the gospel.
- For Adrienne and Hillary that God will use them in a mighty way.
- For our “Children’s Home”, which is still in the works and we are waiting to finish the required bylaws and other legalities.
