"On To Comayagua"

God has prepared our path to Comayagua from Choluteca, Honduras. If you look at the map of Honduras you will find Comayagua north of Choluteca and northwest of the capital, Tegucigalpa. This path opens up an area of over 1,000,000 people to share the gospel with and hundreds of churches and organizations to work with. Our 3 1/2 year stay in Choluteca has produced amazing results that has advanced the kingdom. Under our direction the work in Choluteca will continue through our zone pastor, Elmer Lopez, and others and we expect it to continue to grow just as OEM continues to produce a harvest in Nicaragua under the leadership of Pastor Eduardo Sanchez and others.

During our visit to the area of Comayagua on August 5-7 we established contact with pastors, found our new home, and set up our first team for that home on November 3-9, 2008. The field is ripe for harvest and as we begin to spend a lot of time in that region we need your prayers. As we write this, we are in Costa Rica and this area continues to be blessed with many decisions for Christ, new cell groups, and churches growing. Since June 12th we have had 5 teams in Costa Rica and have witnessed over 1,700 professions of faith.

This month we have a large "cell conference" to lead in Filadelfia, a meeting with the police department in Santa Cruz to begin leadership training and also meetings with the mayors of different cities to propose leadership training for their city councils. Please pray that God will continue to open these doors. As in any large move, such as the ones mentioned above to northern Honduras, many changes will come and we again ask you to pray for us to have wisdom and discernment which only comes from God.

OEM's schedule for 2009 is filling up and our first team will be from TCBC to Managua on January 9-15. If your church is considering a trip to Central America this year we pray you will choose OEM.

Thank all of you for blessing us and praying for us.
